

COOPERATION AGREEMENT

PREAMBLE

TUCN-NUCBM and University PIM, recognizing the importance of educational, cultural and scientific cooperation between international universities and share the same interest in promoting links that can lead to strong and good relations between the two universities to establish the following agreement on cooperation joint maintenance of international scientific conferences (TUCN-NUCBM / IIS, University PIM / STED).

Article I (Objectives)

- 1.1 The main objective of this agreement is to improve international scientific cooperation in the field of scientific research, in the form of maintaining a common conference International Conference, which will give the opportunity to scientific research workers to their knowledge and research achievements presented at the conference.
- 1.2 The partner institutions will:
 - A common work to organize international scientific conference, thereby encouraging scientific research.
 - The exchange of useful information for educational and research activities;
 - Encouraging the development of joint educational and research projects;These objectives are carried out exclusively on a voluntary basis, this agreement serves only to adapt the general terms of the relationship between both sides. Financial terms and details of implementation for each case will have to be defined in a specific work program, which will be approved by the rectors of both universities or their representatives.

Article II (concrete actions)

- 2.1 Both universities undertake to voluntarily join the organization of joint International Scientific Conference.
- 2.2 Both universities will appoint a coordinator who will be responsible for organizing joint International Scientific Conference, and to cooperate in the organization of the same.
- 2.3 Both universities agree to host a joint International Scientific Conference every year to be one of the following two alternating University.
- 2.4 Both the universities agreed to host the first joint International Scientific Conference to be held in 2016, is TUCN-NUCBM.
- 2.5 All registration fees that are paid by the authors of scientific papers will be made available to the University host a joint International Scientific Conference.

- 2.6 Both universities will appoint members of the Scientific, organization and program committee.
- 2.7 Both universities will carry out a review of submitted papers for the joint International Scientific Conference, and submit a list of reviewers.
- 2.8 Both universities may voluntarily exchange of academic materials of mutual interest, which consists in publications, curriculum information and research reports. No institution is obliged to provide specific or predetermined quantity of documents on the other.
- 2.9 Each varsity, whenever it considers it appropriate, may invite representatives of the partner universities to participate in conferences, colloquia, seminars, workshops and research programs and promote joint doctoral programs.
- 2.10 Each university agrees to appoint a coordinator for the administration of this agreement.
- 2.11 Coordinators will serve as a contact person, was responsible for the arrangements with regard to the visit, ensuring that the necessary approval and general welfare of the participants joint international conference.
- 2.12 Coordinators will take joint action to enforce this Agreement, and the improvement of the same.
- 2.13 All documents are necessary for the realization of OVG agreement (letter of invitation, certificate of attendance and others) shall bear a label both universities, signatories OVG Agreement
- 2.14 Special arrangements for exchange visits or for academic or research purposes will be through the coordinator of this Agreement, and with the approval of the authorities of each University.
- 2.15 Coordinators of this agreement are entitled to the name of the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca, North University Centre of Baia Mare Lecturer Eng. Cristian BARZ Ph.D and Vesna RODIC in name University for Business Engineering and Management Banja Luka

Article III (duration)

- 3.1 This Agreement shall enter into force immediately after being signed by the legal representatives of the two universities and will last for a period of five years.

- 3.2 Any institution can terminate the contract, stating the reasons, by giving three months prior written notice to the other.
- 3.3 Any serious breach of this Agreement by giving one else has a right to terminate.
- a) a serious breach of contract is a violation of basic terms relating to the objects or purposes of this Agreement.
- b) a serious breach seems unreliable partner responsible for all damages caused.
- 3.4 If the termination does not indicate a partner three months before the expiration of a period agreed in the Agreement shall remain in force until either partner gives the other notice of termination.

Article IV (Accidental and unforeseen circumstances)

- 4.1 Neither party shall be liable for errors or delays that threaten any obligations imposed by this Agreement in the event of such failures or delays are caused by: fire, explosions, water floods, natural hazards, strikes, vandalism, war, riots, sabotage, or similar causes; nor shall either party be held legally responsible for damage value to material loss or personal property due to such causes.

Article V (Additions or changes to the Contract)

- 5.1 Any additions or changes to this Agreement must be mutually approved by both parties.
- 5.2 The Rector of the University for Business Engineering and Management, Banja Luka (PIM University), as well as the rector of the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca (TUCN-NUCBM), must ratify this agreement.
- 5.3 In witness whereof, the parties have caused this Agreement to be completed by their accordingly authorized representatives as at the date indicated below.

Article VI (legal disputes)

- 6.1 Any dispute arising from this Agreement will first be discussed between the parties involved in order to find a satisfactory solution for all parties.

This Agreement is drawn up in four originals in English language and are kept in two originals by each side.
